

**Chase The Ace Lottery Fundraiser
@ The Woodstock Golf and Curling Club

1. Ticket sales and draws will be held each Friday at The Woodstock Golf and Curling Club in Woodstock, NB. Ticket sales will be from 4:00pm to 6:00pm. Draws will be held at 6:15pm.
2. Two part numbered tickets will be sold at a cost of \$5 per ticket. Ticket sales are restricted to those 19 years of age and older.
3. Distribution of weekly ticket sales:
 - 30% will be awarded to the winning ticket holder
 - 30% will be added to the Prize Pool
 - 40% will go to the Woodstock Golf and Curling Club
4. Each Friday, one winning ticket will be drawn at random from that night's ticket sales. The holder of the winning ticket will win 30% of the nights ticket sales and a chance to draw for the current round's Chase The Ace Jackpot.

6. For each round a new standard deck of 52 cards will be used, with the Ace of Spades being revealed before the draw. Once a card has been drawn it will be signed by the winning ticket holder. The deck will be secured and locked onsite at the Woodstock Golf and Curling Club. This will continue weekly until the Ace of Spades is drawn.
7. When the deck is cut the top card of the bottom half (card that is facing down) will be considered the card that has been drawn. When there are 10 cards remaining they will be shuffled and placed face down on a table for the winning ticket holder to draw.
8. The holder of the winning ticket must be in attendance to claim the prize. The winning ticket number will be called 3 times and displayed visually during a 15 minute time frame. If the winner does not come forward another ticket will be drawn. Signs indicating the winner must be in attendance will be posted in the venue.
9. Woodstock Golf and Curling Club staff and Board of Directors are not permitted to purchase tickets.
10. Any winner who is paid a prize will automatically be deemed to grant to the Woodstock and Curling Club an irrevocable right to publish, through all types of media broadcasting, including the internet, for the purposes of promoting the win, their full name, hometown and photograph without any claim for broadcasting, printing or other rights. The winner who is paid a prize also gives the WGCC the right to publish any additional information that they voluntarily provide. The winner shall have no claim against the WGCC for invasion of privacy or any other ground(s) by reason of the publication or broadcasting of their Name, Hometown or photograph or information voluntarily provided by the winner.
11. The winner will provide their full name, address and phone number to the Woodstock Golf and Curling Club representative in attendance for reporting requirements to Alcohol & Gaming. The address and phone number will NOT be made public.
